**Note :** The school organizes the tailoring of the clothes (Part A Items No.2 to 8). Measurement for the same must be given at the time of admission.

**Toiletries :** Hair oil, comb, fine - tooth comb, shoe brush , boot polish (black), nail cutter, soap ( bathing and washing), shampoo, tooth brush, tooth paste, tongue cleaner, mug, pens, pencils,erasers, 4 small locks with duplicate keys for cupboards and classroom desks with two key chains with boarding number written. Parents will ensure that their children have all other personal items, particularly those related to health and hygiene.

**Stationery:** Pen, pencils, Erasers, Plastic Ruler, Geometry Box, Colour Pencils, Cryons, Drawing paint & Brush, A4 size papers for project work etc....

Boarding Number tapes will be supplied by the school. All items mentioned, except items 18 and 22 should have these numbers affixed on them. It should be stitched neatly without being seen externally. You are not permitted to write the boarding number with coloured marker pens on external clothes.

Those who fail to bring any of the above mentioned items will not be admitted to the school hostel on the reporting day.

Extra sets of dress and any other items which are not mentioned in the above list need not be brought to the school. Only one Large suitcase and a small handbag are permitted in the dormitory. Other suitcases and bags must be taken back by the parents after arranging their clothes in the cupboard provided.

Students are not permitted to borrow any item what so ever from their companions ( clothes, games equipments, books, notebooks and other stationery items. )

On the reporting day ( 07.06.2020) you are requested to bring two copies of the list of items. One list is to be submitted to the Matron and the other to be retained by the student / parents for future reference. The list of items will be checked by the Matron / Warden before the boarder is admitted to the dormitory on the reporting day ( 07.06.2020) i.e one day prior to the re - opening day.

Parents will collect the **Admit card** for their son/ daughter from the class ( Special counter ) on 07.06.2020 for admission to the dormitory. Those who have not completed the formalities of admission, payment of fees and have not brought the items mentioned in the above list will not receive the **Admit Card**
